Working Methods

I firmly believe in the value of a trusting relationship between supervisor and supervisee, which enables a negotiated agreement of where on the support/challenge continuum the focus will sit. My role is to hold space, allowing the supervisee to reflect, gain insight and determine their own actions and outcomes that will support their ongoing growth as a coach. With permission I will share observations and feedback but ultimately it is the coaches' own clarity of perspective that will shape continuous professional development.

As a mindfulness teacher, I also value the importance of 'presence' for both myself and those I support and, where relevant (and with permission) I will introduce complementary aspects of mindfulness to the reflective process.
